SIGN LANGUAGE CLASSES IN KILLARNEY

Killarney Community College are hoping to run a Sign Language Class as part of their Adult Education Programme.

This programme is suitable for individuals who wish to develop skills in Irish Sign Language for effective communication with Deaf and hard of hearing relatives, employees and customers in a variety of situations.

The course equips students with enough sign language skills to introduce themselves and conduct a basic conversation with another sign language user: communicate in a social setting, give personal information in response to questions, show understanding and express simple passages in Irish Sign Language (ISL).

The course will run on Tuesdays for 9 weeks from 7:30-9:30 p.m. The cost for the course is 110 euros.
