There will be a raffle too on the night with lots of prizes. All money raised at this event will go towards the Ambo Lazarist Deaf School (ALDS) in Ethiopia.

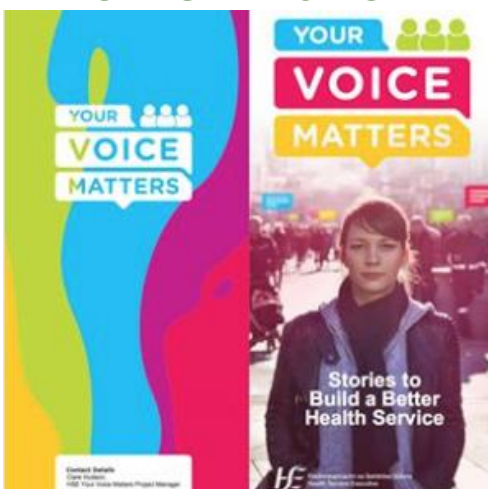
The table quiz is open to both Deaf & hearing and it promises to be a great night.

It will be held on the 7th & 8th of October at Dánlann an Chláir, Ennis, Co. Clare.

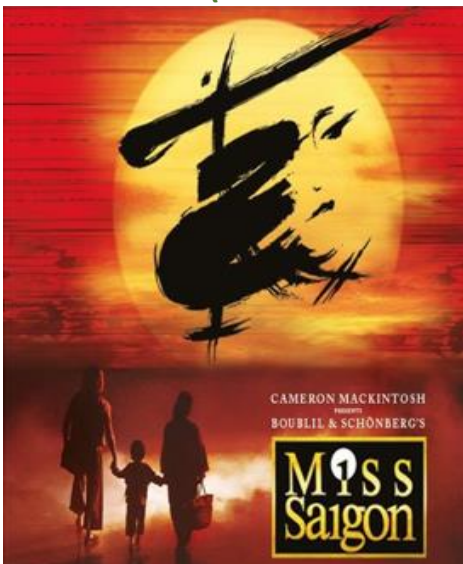
Two sign language interpreters have been booked for the event. Tickets are €25.00 for individual women & €50.00 for the community & voluntary sector. To book tickets, go to
