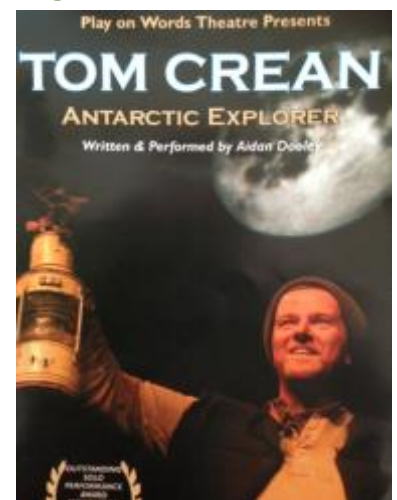
IRISH SIGN LANGUAGE (ISL) ACCESS- 'TOM CREAN- ANTARCTIC EXPLORER'.
